

PACE Scholarship Information

- Students who wish to request financial assistance for a PACE production may apply for a scholarship. However, due to the overwhelming number of requests, we have adopted a policy of partial scholarships of 50 to 75%. Scholarships are based on need and all information will be kept confidential. PLEASE NOTE: There are no restrictions based on race, creed, religion, or national origin. If you are unable to print the application form, please email Lisa Huskey at pacelhuskey@gmail.com and one be mailed to you.
- To offset the cost of granting scholarships, we ask that all scholarship recipients sell tickets to the production for which they receive a scholarship. The ticket sales must equal the amount of reduced tuition. If students are unable to sell the agreed upon amount of tickets, they will be responsible for payment of the difference in tuition. To Apply:

1. Print out and complete the application and agreement form below. Bring to auditions, the parent meeting, or mail to the address below.
2. Request two letters of recommendation from a teacher, school counselor, youth leader, employer, or other non-relative. The person making the recommendation must mail the letter separately to the address below:
